## Soil & Water

Do you know the difference between soil and dirt? The whole world depends on a thin layer of soil to feed all the people. Without water, all living creatures including people can not survive on Planet Earth.

## Seeds and Plants

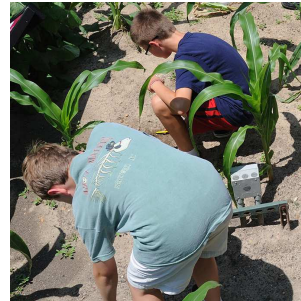


Did you know that a whole corn plant is inside each small seed. Students will look inside a seed and see this little plant. We depend on plants for food,

medicine, clothing, houses, and so much more. Students will explore the world of plants and will plant a sunflower seed to take home and watch it grow. They will also discover gardening and how gardeners transplant small plants into organized spaces to grow food. Students will transplant a tomato plant into a peat cup to take home and plant in their own little garden.

## Native American Gardens

Native Americans taught the Pilgrims on the Mayflower how to survive in the New World. One of the things that the Pilgrims learned from the Native Americans was how plants interact with one another and help each other to grow. They grew a Three Sisters Garden that included Corn, Beans and Squash. Students will learn about companion planting using a Three Sisters Garden and will take home a packet of seeds to plant their own Three Sisters Garden.
